What are Web Conferences?

Sensory Connection Program Web Conferences are two to three hour mini-trainings on specific subjects. Each Web Conference is designed in collaboration with the contracting facilities to meet the specific needs of their program. These Web conferences are used best by small groups of key staff members who are working toward bringing a sensory approach to treatment to their program, developing a sensory room, or adding sensory based groups.

What Subjects Do SCP Web Conferences Cover?

Web Conferences can cover a broad range of sensory related topics depending on the needs of a facility and the client population. These are a few examples:

- The Sensory Connection Program: Development and Implementation
- Sensory Room Development: Environments for Self-regulation and Sensory Exploration
- The Sensory Connection Approach to Restraint/Seclusion Reduction and Trauma Informed Care: Moving from Being Cared For to Care of the Self

How Do Web Conferences Work?

- You will see a Power Point Presentation on your computer screen.
- You will connect live with Karen via the telephone. You will hear a live presentation and share questions and comments throughout the presentation.
- There is no live video component to this type of Web Conference and you will not see Karen live. Presentations often include pictures of Karen demonstrating various activities and pieces of equipment.
- Group meetings (more than one participant) will need the technical ability to project video and audio input.
- Participants can also join from other locations using their own laptop and telephone line.
- Scheduling and joining the Web Conference is easy. Participants or Groups will be sent an invitation with an agreed upon time, telephone number for connecting, participant code, and link for the internet connection. That connection can be checked ahead of time by following another link on the invitation.
- It is as simple as that. The web conference platform provided by SaveOn Conferences is very easy to use and participants can talk back and forth with Karen throughout the seminar.
